Admission Requirements:

- Minimum Bachelor's degree from any recognized University/College.

Diploma Requirements:

Students must complete the following 6 (six) courses with a minimum 2.5 CGPA.

Term I:

1. PGD 1210: Fundamental of HRM
2. PGD 1212: Employee Relations & Employment Laws in Bangladesh
3. PGD 1223: Performance Appraisal Management

Term II:

4. PGD 1213: Training & Development
5. PGD 1221: Organization Design and Development
6. PGD 1222: Compensation and Benefit Management

Common Features of PGDHRM

Program Structure:

The program is structured to be completed within 22 weeks of study while each course is to be completed within 11 weeks of study. The program consists of 6 (six) courses of 18 credit hours, each having 3 credits.

Class Schedule: Three classes per week on Friday only.

Morning Session: 8:00 am - 12:45 pm

Afternoon Session: 2:30 pm - 4:30 pm

Admission Fees: BDT 8,000

Tuition Fees: BDT 4,500 per course; total BDT 27,000

All classes will be offered during evenings or on weekly holidays to accommodate students who wish to complete the program on a part-time basis. It will be a training based practical oriented program.

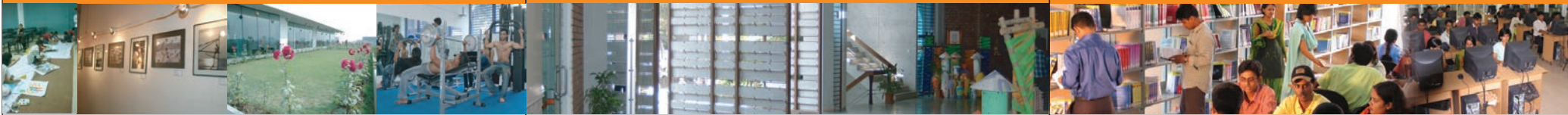
